From 26 June, the following applies:



Clubs and discos open



Water parks open



Working from home a recommendation not a requirement



COVID certificate

Compulsory: clubs, discos and large-scale events
Voluntary: smaller events, sporting, cultural and leisure facilities, restaurants



Events



With certificate
No restrictions



Without certificate, but with seating requirement
Max. 1000 people



Without certificate, no seating requirement
Outdoors: max. 500 people
Indoors: max. 250 people



Requirement to wear masks



Lifted outdoors



Relaxed in the workplace (employer decides)



Relaxed at upper secondary and vocational schools (cantons decide)



Restaurants

Outdoors: no restrictions
Indoors: contact details from one person per group



Sporting and cultural activities

Outdoors: no restrictions
Indoors: contact details
Choir performances also allowed indoors

Still applicable:



Requirement to wear masks indoors: at events without a COVID certificate requirement, in restaurants and shops and on public transport



Private gatherings of up to 30 people (outdoors: 50 people)



Recommendation: Get yourself vaccinated!

Situation	Measures
General	Only vaccinated / tested / recovered persons are admitted to the DevOpsDays Zurich 2021. No distance rules apply.

Construction

Situation	Measures
Alte Kaserne	Mask obligation: All persons must wear a mask.

Conference

Situation	Measures
General	Masks are mandatory in the public spaces of the Alte Kaserne. A mask recommendation applies in the conference rooms. Masks are available at check-in if individual guests do not have any with them.
Alte Kaserne / Check-in	Check-in is open from 08:00 to 17:00, participants are advised to arrive on time. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In front of the building: Participants steered with cords in lanes to the entrance 2. Sign with registration instructions (surname, first name and telephone number) and note to have ID and COVID certificate ready. 3. 2 people scan the certificates with the COVID app. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. If Green <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Person receives COVID wristband and is allowed into the building to pick up the badge. b. If Red <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Person is sent to the information booth. A person receives information where they can take a test. 4. Only people with a wristband and a badge are allowed to enter the building. The people will be scanned again on the second day with ID verification and will receive a new COVID wristband. Persons with the wristband from the previous day will only be scanned without ID verification.
Access To the Alte Kaserne	Entrance and exit are not separated (not possible).
Foyer	Masks are mandatory in the Foyer.
Saal	A mask recommendation applies in the Saal. In the Saal there are only as many chairs as participants are allowed. Only participants of the conference have access to the Saal. Verification is done via badge.

Workshop rooms	A mask recommendation applies in the workshop rooms.
Open Space Spaces	A mask recommendation applies in the open-space rooms.
Catering	Coffee takes place in the Saal. Food takes place in the Foyer, workshop rooms and terrace at tables. Eating is only allowed while sitting.
Sanitary facilities	The sanitary facilities are in the Foyer. Masks are mandatory here.

Situation	Measures
Boiler Room	Access only with conference badge and COVID wristband. A mask recommendation applies in the Boiler Room.

COVID Certificate

The sanitary facilities are signposted, open and accessible.
Each participant receives a personal hand disinfectant in the swag bag.
Employees at the registration desk wash their hands before the start and end of the assignment as well as before and after breaks, and disinfectants are also available at the registration desk.
